Key Note Speaker: Dr Liubov Volkova; Department of Forest and Ecosystem Science University of Melbourne: Forest Carbon Balance and Emission

Management.

Dr Liubov Volkova is a research fellow at the University of Melbourne working on the impacts of fuel reduction burning on carbon losses in eucalypt forests across Australia including SE Queensland.

The research is part of the *Fire in the Landscape project* within the Bushfire CRC *Managing the Threat program* and is supported here in SEQ by the Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service.

**Other Topics**— updates on fire research in SEQ; SEQ Roadside Fire Management Project; CfoC Eastern Bristle Bird Project; Fire Weather Update; Late Quaternary vegetation and fire history from the Moon Point Patterned Fen, Fraser Island; Pre and Post European settlement fire history and environmental impacts from the Atherton Tableland region.
